Ketcham Inn Foundation, Inc. (KIFI) is very pleased to have been awarded a Grant from the Robert David Lion Gardiner Foundation to develop the *Ketcham Inn Digital Tapestry Project* relating to the American Revolution.

The 1776AR Digital Tapestry Project will capture digitally and bring to life in animated form the history of the American Revolution embodied in the Ketcham Inn and Moriches Bay Area. The Digital Tapestry will retell local Revolutionary history by means of a professional storyteller and an augmented reality smartphone app. Users will experience an informative, digitally-aided tour of the Ketcham Inn site.

The Robert David Lion Gardiner Foundation, established in 1987, primarily supports the study of Long Island history and its role in the American experience. Robert David Lion Gardiner was, until his death in August 2004, the 16th Lord of the Manor of Gardiner Island, NY. His descendants have owned Gardiner Island since 1639, obtained as part of a royal grant by King Charles I of England.
